(Rochester, NY) 06/01/05 - Attracting younger people to downtown was the topic of a meeting Tuesday night. Young professionals voiced their concerns on topics such as crime, parking, shopping at the town hall style meeting.

These young people are looking to local leaders to act on their ideas. Many want to see the city thrive and that includes attracting others.

Jennafer Manetta of the Rochester City Coalition said, "[It's about] Finding a way for suburban residents to ... have a reason to come into the city...they have no destination, no reason to bring their children into our city right now."
